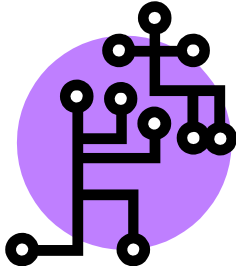

What is the Supervised Visitation Service?



We provide a safe and secure setting for parents to play with their children.

All families experience problems. Sometimes these problems result in the separation of spouses and/or children being removed from the home. In an effort to strengthen families, the Family Resource and Referral Center strives to provide a safe, neutral place where children and parents can visit comfortably with each other. Visits can be referred to us through the Department of Social Services, the court system or other community agencies with clients who may benefit from this service.

Who Supervises the Visits?

A staff member is always present to supervise and take notes during a visit. Our two Parent Educators have completed “Parents as Teachers” training and have hands-on experience supervising visits.

“Parents as Teachers” is a research-based curriculum which emphasizes the belief that parents are their child’s first and best teachers.

Who Pays for the Service?

The cost is \$35/hour per worker. If your case is referred by the Department of Social Services, we will bill them. For a court-ordered supervised visit, parents must pay the fee privately before visits can take place. We have a sliding scale fee based on income. If you are eligible for this, you will have a small set fee payable in advance and we have funds to cover the remaining portion of the cost.

For visits referred by the Department of Social Services, the social worker, parents, foster parents and the Parent Educator will work together to find an appropriate time. For court-ordered visits, the visiting parent must contact a Parent Educator to schedule an orientation session, payment schedule and a time for the visits. This also needs to be coordinated with the custodial parent.

Visits normally take place for one hour, one time per week.
